At King Edward Park:

(Stratford's family, picnic, dog, and climber friendly park)

Sunday 5th of February 2012: Mountain Climbing

At the National Park:

The first 1,100 meters are free (you can drive); Then a transit from the Stratford Plateau car park to the Tahurangi Lodge, then a climb up the Northern Summit Route.

King Edward Park: A combination of Park, Bush, and River – Twenty acres established in well, the name'll give you a clue. KEP is a climber friendly, dog friendly, picnic friendly, family friendly kind of park – so bring the family, dog, picnic basket *and* your climbing gear.

Stratford: A mountain town very nearly equidistant from Auckland and Wellington on State Highway Three. Stratford has streets named for Shakespeare's characters, and New Zealand's only glockenspiel clock tower.

Egmont National Park: Pretty cool.
