Rigging with the PORT-A-WRAP Workshop

The Port-A-Wrap is the most commonly used friction device for tree rigging. It can be used in numerous ways to make the arborist's job easier.

The Rigging with the Port-A-Wrap workshop will cover:

- New ways to attach the Port-A-Wrap to the tree
- How to lift loads with the Port-A-Wrap
- How different ropes react in conjunction with the Port-A-Wrap
- How to tension rigging ropes using the Port-A-Wrap
- How to reduce the forces on the rigging anchor

The workshop will contribute to a better appreciation of the Port-A-Wrap's potential and limitations in tree work. The participants will also gain a greater understanding of the forces involved in rigging and how these forces can affect the job.
